

VOICE ACTING AUDITION GUIDELINES:

1. BEFORE you deliver/perform the material required for the audition tape, please ensure that you clearly state YOUR NAME, and the ROLE you are auditioning for. This is called your "SLATE."
2. Your slate may be recorded separately, and edited to the END of your audio recording, OR you may go into your slate right after your audition material in one take.
3. You may get someone else to read for the other role in the audition side, but if you do not have access to a reader, you may simply leave a space in your performance as if listening to the other character speak.
4. DO NOT read the lines for any characters that you are not auditioning for in the specific audition taping, and do not read character names or the prompt before the piece. The prompt is only to give context to guide your interpretations of the characters.
5. Once you have finished recording, save you audio file as an **MP3** and label the file in the following format "VOICE ACTING AUDITION_ NAME OF CHARACTER_Your Name"

Go to the next page for the audition sides

Kellon/ Lea(5) is missing one side of his/her blue and purple sock. Dad/Mom is holding the side of the sock Kellon/Lea already has. Kellon/Lea goes to the drawer and pulls out a yellow sock with green stripes. He/She carries it and compares it to the one side of the sock that Dad/Mom is holding. Kellon/Lea puts the two sides of the sock together.

DAD/MOM

Is that the correct sock?

KELLON/ LEA

(slowly, stretching her words)

Yeeaaeaa.....

(looks at her mom's face)

(quickly)

No! This is a yellow sock!
She puts it back and starts looking again

KELLON/ LEA

(without looking at dad/mom)
I was testing yooouuu

DAD/ MOM

Look again, it's in there, I'm sure.
